SERVICE DISRUPTION IN PARTS OF NORTH-EAST TRINIDAD

The Water and Sewerage Authority (the Authority) advises customers in parts of **North East Trinidad** served by the **Hollis Water Treatment Plant** that, there will be an interruption in the water supply from **10:00 p.m. on Wednesday 12th February, to 6:00 a.m. on Thursday 13th February 2025.**

This has become necessary, in order to facilitate the replacement of a defective 24" valve at the corner of O'Meara Road and the Priority Bus Route, Arima.
