UPDATE: EMERGENCY REPAIRS AT THE CARONI WATER TREATMENT PLANT COMPLETED

The Water and Sewerage Authority (“WASA”) advises customers in parts of North, Central and South Trinidad, served by the Caroni Water Treatment Plant that emergency repairs at the plant’s raw water station, was completed at approximately 10:30 a.m. today - Friday 3rd October, 2025.

Production at the Plant has been restored to 75 million gallons per day (mgd), however, customers are advised that it may take up to twenty-four (24) hours for the supply to be fully restored in some affected areas.

A limited truck-borne water service is available with priority being given to health facilities, schools and homes for the aged.
