

WASA ANNOUNCES INTERIM WATER SUPPLY SCHEDULES FOR BARRACKPORE AREAS AMID LOW PRESSURE CHALLENGES

Wednesday 4th March 2026: The Water and Sewerage Authority (WASA) advises residents and customers in several Barrackpore areas of adjusted interim supply schedules due to persistently low pressures within the system. These disruptions, compounded by ongoing dry season conditions, have temporarily altered the normal rotational supply.

The Authority has implemented interim schedules to manage the available supply effectively and ensure equitable distribution. The following areas will receive a water supply from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. according to the tentative dates listed below:

Oropouche South Trace	6:00am- 6:00pm	10.03.26 - 17.03.26
Kanhai North Road	6:00am- 6:00pm	17.03.26 - 20.03.26
From #2 Bridge to Clarke Road Booster (all side streets)	6:00am- 6:00pm	03.03.26 - 22.03.26
