

WASA TO COMPLETE FINAL REPAIR WORKS TODAY TO IMPROVE WATER SUPPLY TO UPPER SANTA CRUZ

Tuesday 19th May 2026: The Water and Sewerage Authority (WASA) advises customers in Upper Santa Cruz, including the communities of Pax Vale, Sam Boucaud and El Guamal, that final repair and maintenance works at the Santa Cruz Booster Station are expected to be completed today, Tuesday 19th May 2026.

These works form part of ongoing efforts to stabilise the Valsayn/Santa Cruz distribution network following a series of infrastructure challenges, compounded by reduced water availability during the prolonged dry season period.

Over the past several weeks, the Authority has undertaken repairs to a 12-inch transmission main near the Santa Cruz Booster Station, along with critical maintenance works at both the Valsayn and Santa Cruz Booster Stations. These activities impacted the transfer and distribution of water to elevated areas within the Upper Santa Cruz district.

WASA advises that once the current works are completed and the system is fully stabilised, the scheduled pipe-borne water supply to affected communities will be progressively restored within approximately 24 to 48 hours.

The Authority acknowledges the inconvenience experienced by customers and thanks residents for their continued patience and understanding as every effort is made to restore a reliable water supply in the shortest possible timeframe.
